For those students entering the CSP with a Master's degree in psychology from another institution (or department within the University of Hawai'i), the clinical faculty will review the requirements that were met in fulfillment of the degree and assess the student's competence in research related skills. If there are deficiencies in comparison to our own Master's students, the faculty will require a research project to be completed under PSY 779. Except under rare circumstances, no more than three core courses will be exempted. For those students entering with a Ph.D. outside psychology, each case will be determined on an individual basis.
