

Experimental Psychopathology Comprehensive Exam is required and here is a description:

The Comprehensive Examination consists of an oral defense of an article published in or submitted to a professional journal or book. The article must concern a topic related to experimental psychopathology. The Comprehensive Exam will be administered and graded as pass-fail by three Experimental Psychopathology faculty. For a student to pass the exam, at least two of the three EP faculty graders must score the oral defense as a pass. Students who fail the exam may petition the EP faculty to take it again. Petitions are considered on a case by case basis. Failure of the exam may result in termination from the EP Concentration.
